

## Wheel Measurer Instructions

### Wheel Measurement Tasks:

1. Measure Track Width of each Competitor
  - a. Place cones (flat side in) against widest part of the wheels with the carriage at a full halt. (BACK wheels for a 4-wheeled carriage – does not matter if front wheels are wider.)
  - b. Ask the competitor to drive forward and be sure they do not “nudge” the cones in the process – if they do have them halt again and redo the previous step.
  - c. Use the measuring stick provided, determine the wheel measurement in centimeters.
2. Record Competitor Number and Track Width on the Blank Wheel Measurement Form.
3. Calculate the total measurement for the competitor by adding the clearance for their level to the wheel measurement. Record this on the Wheel Measurement form. You will be given a calculator if needed!
4. If wheels are being measured right before cones, radio the measurement of the next competitor to the cones crew while the previous driver is on-course. Otherwise, return your completed measurement sheet to the office.
