

**54th ANNUAL GMHA JUNIOR HORSEMANSHIP CLINIC
SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION**

Scholarships to GMHA's Junior Horsemanship Clinic are awarded on the basis of financial need. GMHA's scholarship committee will review all scholarship applications. The information provided here will be kept confidential and limited to committee members.

As an educational organization, GMHA is committed to making it possible for qualified applicants to receive the highest possible level of support; however, scholarship funds are limited. Please be aware that **the quality and completeness of this application will influence the amount awarded**. To improve fairness of the process, we are asking this year for applicant's parents to provide proof of their income by attaching a copy of the appropriate IRS document for 2009.

Places in the JHC are available on a first-come, first-served basis, and a \$250 deposit is required to hold a spot regardless of the amount of scholarship assistance requested.

Scholarship applications must be received by Friday, April 16, 2009. Applications received after that date will not be considered. Applications must include proof of last year's income as described above, or they will be returned as incomplete. Scholarship will be awarded on a rolling basis. Scholarship funds are limited so application should be submitted in a timely manner.
