Individual Jumping Rounds

Jumping Rounds may be purchased individually or in addition to Combined Test Entries. If adding a round in addition to a Combined Test, your **FIRST ROUND** will count for Combined Test score. Must jump within time slot allotted for each height- will be posted with dressage times on our website.

New Mix and Match Option! Ride any Dressage Test with any height jumping round! Mix and match Combined Tests will be scored as their own division.

3. BEGINNER NOVICE LEVEL	
Dressage Test: USEF 2010 Beginner Novice Test B	Stadium: 2'7"
4. NOVICE LEVEL	
Dressage Test: USEF 2010 Novice Test B	Stadium: 2'11"

- ◆ This event will be run according to USEA Rules.
- ◆ Show Management reserves the right to combine, split, or cancel divisions as entries warrant.
- ◆ Trophy & Ribbons 1st-6th given in each combined test division.
- ◆ Riders may compete in multiple divisions.
- ◆ Scratches prior to closing date must be received in writing and will be refunded minus a \$15 administrative fee. No refunds for scratches after closing date unless we can fill your space.
- ◆ Individual jumping rounds are guaranteed if pre-registered. May be added at the gate if time permits.
- ◆ Individual jumping rounds will be judged and placed as a class at each height. Fastest clear round will win.
- ◆ Individual jumping rounds are offered at combined test heights only- no exceptions.
