Learn what the judges are looking for in the new 2010 USEF Dressage Tests and improve your dressage score at your next competition! Ride a dressage test of your choice from the list on the form below, each participant will ride their test, followed by feedback and instruction from the judge. You will then ride the test again and be judged. The judge will score both tests, and each rider will receive both score sheets. The cost of the critique is \$50. Ride times will fill up quickly.

## Cross-Country Rally: Sunday May 2, 2010

Put your cross-country skills to work and practice riding a course! Fences will be set in GMHA's Upwey Ring for Elementary, Beginner Novice, Novice, and Training levels. Select the level of your choice, and ride two rounds. Your first round will be an un-judged schooling round. Second round will be judged according to USEA cross-country rules for the level (Elementary level not timed, only jumping faults added, time limit loosely enforced). All clear rounds (no jumping or time faults) will receive a prize! Divisions will be split Jr/Sr if entries warrant. Special prize for "Most Stylish Round" at each level.

1. Elementary Level: 8 fences not to exceed 2'3". Time limit only.
2. Beginner Novice Level: 8-10 fences not to exceed 2'7". 300 mpm.
3. Novice Level: 10-12 fences not to exceed 2'11". 350 mpm.
4. Training Level- 10-12 fences not to exceed 3'3". 375-400 mpm.
