## Wednesday Afternoon Schooling Shows

### Rules, Policies, and Notes:

Competition ring has sand footing and will be approx. 120'x280'- taped off, no permanent fence. Warm-up area has sand footing, is open (no fencing) right next to competition ring.

There will be no longing allowed in warm-up area during show hours. Longing will be allowed in separate area on grounds, and before the start of competition in the show warm-up.

Formal attire and braiding is encouraged but not required. Horse and rider tack/attire should be clean and tidy with a good fit.

Show management reserves the right to cancel, combine, or split classes as entries warrant, and change the show schedule as it deems necessary.

Vet and farrier will be on-call during the show. EMT on-grounds.

Horses may only be ridden by those who have signed the appropriate entry blank.

No charge to add or scratch a class before the class begins. Scratches not accepted after the start of a class.

Rider is responsible for reading and understanding class specifications. Please contact Karey with any questions.

USEF rules will be used as guidelines for all areas not specifically addressed in rules or class specifications. Please see [www.usef.org](http://www.usef.org).

Unjudged warm-ups may be added to the schedule IF time allows.

Series end awards will only be given if at least three riders compete in the division at each show.

### Class Specifications

**Leadline:** Open to riders age 9 and under. To be shown at the walk, with short trot/jog.

**Equitation:** To be shown at the walk, trot/jog, or canter/lope both ways of the ring. To be judged on hands, seat, and control of mount. May be asked to back.

**Pleasure:** To be shown at the walk, trot/jog, or canter/lope both ways of the ring. May be asked to back. To be judged on performance, manners, soundness, and the horse/pony's suitability to serve as a pleasure mount.

**Open:** Open to riders of all seats. To be shown at the walk, trot/jog, canter/lope both ways of the ring.

**Beginner:** Open to riders 12 years of age and under who have not competed in any class requiring canter. To be asked to walk and trot ONLY both ways of the ring. May not cross-enter into any class requiring canter.

**Hunter Hack:** To be shown at specified gaits both ways of the ring. Also to be show individually over two simple fences at specified height. To be judged on performance, soundness, and the suitability of the horse to be a hunter.

## Wednesday Afternoon Schooling Shows Class Specifications Continued...

### Fun and Games

**Egg and Spoon:** To be judged at specified gaits both ways of the ring with rider balancing an egg on a spoon. Competitor is eliminated when the egg falls- class continues until only one competitor remains.

**Simon Says:** Judged on the horse and rider's ability to follow the announcer's instructions. Announcer to call out commands (change of gait, halt, reinback, ect), exhibitor must obey command by the count of 3 or be eliminated. Class continues until one horse remains.

**Pick Your Route:** Rider must cross the start/finish line to start, jump all fences in any order, and then cross the finish line again. Rider who does not jump all fences will be eliminated. Fastest time to complete course wins.

### Equitation Divisions

**Short/Long Stirrup Equitation:** Open to riders 12 years of age and under (Short Stirrup) or riders 13 years of age or older (Long Stirrup) who have not competed over 2'6". May not cross-enter into other equitation division, or any classes with fences exceeding 2'3". To be shown at the walk, trot, and canter on the flat- no more than 8 riders to canter at one time. Course to consist of 4-8 cross-rails not to exceed 18". Simple changes acceptable.

**Classes will be split Short/Long if entries warrant.**

**Children's Equitation 2'-2'3":** For riders under 18 who have not won three blue ribbons at a recognized show. May not cross-enter into any other class where fences exceed 2'6". To be shown at the walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring on the flat. Fences not to exceed 2'3".

**Modified Adult Amateur Equitation 2'-2'3":** For adult amateur riders. Not to cross-enter into any other class where fences exceed 2'6". To be shown at the walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring on the flat. Fences not to exceed 2'3".

**Children's Equitation 2'6"-2'9":** Open to junior riders. May not cross-enter into any other equitation division. To be shown at the walk, trot, and canter on the flat. Fences not to exceed 2'9".

**Adult Amateur Equitation 2'6"-2'9":** Open to adult amateur riders. May not cross-enter into any other equitation division. To be shown at the walk, trot, and canter on the flat. Fences not to exceed 2'9".

### Jumper Classes

**Table II, 1:** Fastest clear round wins the class. No jump off.

**Table II, 2b:** Rounds with no faults (jumping or time) stay in the ring after completing the course. When the judge signals, rider immediately begins jump off round.

**Puddle Jumper:** Open to all riders. May not cross-enter into any class where fences exceed 2'6" at the same show. Fences not to exceed 2'3".

**Elementary Jumper:** Open to all riders. May not cross-enter into any class where fences exceed 2'9" at the same show. Fences not to exceed 2'6"

**Schooling Jumper:** Open to all riders. Fences not to exceed 3'.

**Low Jumper:** Open to all riders. Fences not to exceed 3'3".
