Dressage Tests- same for both

- Training Level- Test 4 POM
- Preliminary Level- Test 6 POM
- Intermediate Level- Test 5 POM

VSE's to compete in 20x40 arena.

Pace: For Continuous Event: 3k pace from dressage to cones. Terrain is trails and open fields, many water crossings and some hills.

Cones: Standard cones setting, no bridges or water obstacle

VSE's and Multiples welcome- will have their own division if at least 3 entries compete. Open and Novice divisions will be split Horse/Pony if entries warrant (show management's discretion).

Open Division: Open to all single horses, single ponies, VSE's, and multiples.

Novice Division: Open to novice horses, ponies, and drivers.

Schedule: Stables and secretaries office opens Thursday 9/21 at 10am. Dressage start time TBA for Friday. 8am start on Saturday. Arena obstacles Saturday afternoon. Cones to follow dressage.

Other Info: Negative coggins, proof of rabies and fl/rhino within 12 months required with entry. Food available on grounds during show hours. There is no cell phone service at GMHA- wifi is available.

Directions to Show: GMHA is on Rte 106 - 6 miles south of Woodstock, VT; From West NY Thruway: To I-87 Northway to exit 20. Take Rte 149 to Fort Ann, then Rt. 4 to Rutland & Woodstock. Take Rt. 106 south 6 miles to GMHA. From South: I-91 to Ascutney, exit 8, Rt. 131 west 7 miles to Rte 106 north, 11 miles to GMHA. From North & East: I-89 to exit 1 in VT. Take Rt. 4 into Woodstock. Then Rt.106 south to GMHA.
