Scholarships to GMHA's Junior Horsemanship Clinic are awarded on a first come, first serve rolling basis and are based on financial need. GMHA's scholarship committee will review all scholarship applications. The information provided here will be kept confidential and limited to committee members.

To apply for a JHC scholarship, please return with the following information no later than Friday, April 12, 2019:

- A completed JHC Entry Form
- A completed Scholarship Application form and written answers to the questions below
- IRS document 1040 showing your adjusted gross income for 2018
- A \$250 deposit (deposit is required to hold a spot regardless of the amount of scholarship assistance requested).

Incomplete applications or applications received after April 12th will not be considered.
